

PhD Viva Pass!

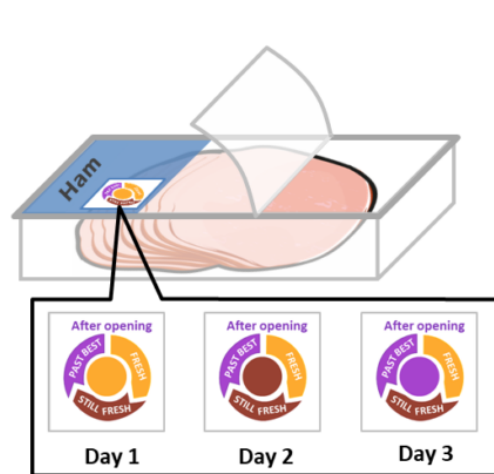
